Dear Parents/Carers

Flamingo Land - Wednesday 17th November

This term KS1 children are learning about Animals, including Humans, and to support our curriculum learning, we are planning a trip to Flamingo Land on Wednesday 17th November. In addition to this, Year 1/2 have invited our Reception children (who are learning about bears) to join them for a wildlife lunch.

During the day, the children will participate in a habitat workshop and visit the onsite zoo.

The children will leave school at 9:15am prompt and travel by coach to Flamingo Land, returning at approximately 3:45pm. Your child will need to come to school in their school uniform and bring with them a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks, chocolate or yoghurt please), a warm waterproof coat and a small backpack in which to carry their lunch.

We are asking for parents to both consent and pay for this trip via Parent Pay, by 22nd October 2021. To cover the cost of this trip we are asking for a donation of £15 per child, unfortunately if insufficient donations are received the trip will not be able to run. Whilst we recognise that the cost of school trips can be expensive, we believe it is important for all of our children to experience residential / out of school visits and would very much like to ensure that every child has the opportunity to take part. If you are experiencing financial difficulties, please speak to either the school office or the Headteacher in confidence, as there are partial bursaries / subsidies funded by both FoNR and a historical School Fund available for a limited number of trip places.
