We have had an exciting term developing our Art and Music knowledge and skills through our 'We are Artists' project. We began our project discussing Ghandi's quote:

Over the past term, we have discussed and learnt about the issues of 'fast fashion' and the impact this can have on the environment. We have learnt about fashion sustainability and how we can use the 4 R's to help improve this situation.
