It was great to be all together for Sports Day. The children thoroughly enjoyed the event as did the parents. We are so pleased we can, at last, welcome you to our school events.






This week on Tuesday 14th June it was the Great Science Share. This is an opportunity for primary school children to share their great Science work with other people. In Science week at the start of this term, all the classes carried out a directed experiment linked to Climate Change. Year 3 and 4 flourished with their learning by using what they had learnt to design their own investigation. The children investigated which materials reflected light and then decided to investigate how these materials could help the growth of plants. They investigated whether foil or CDs would help the growth of Sweet Peas over time. The results were interesting and led to lots of discussions about experimental error! Well done Busy Bees for a great investigation.
