Year 5/6 Residential

Bewerley Park Outdoor Centre, 15th – 19th May 2023

In Year 5 and 6 the children get the opportunity to take part in residential trips that enhance their learning as well as build self-confidence, teamwork, and independence – essential skills which help prepare them for the transition to secondary education. In May 2023, we are thrilled to be able to take the children Bewerley Park near Pateley Bridge for a 5-day, 4-night residential stay.

The full cost of the residential week is **£385** and we have taken the decision to launch the trip early to enable payments to be made in instalments over the next 6 months. We are asking for parents to both consent and pay for this trip via Parent Pay.

A **£50** non-refundable deposit is required to secure your child's place (payable by **14th October 2022**), thereafter the balance can be paid in full or in 3 instalments;

- 1st instalment of £100 payable by 5th December 2022
- 2nd instalment of £100 payable by 24th February 2023
- 3rd instalment of £135 payable by 28th April 2023

with the trip being paid in full by the **28th April 2023**.

Whilst we recognise that the cost of School Trips of can be expensive, we believe it is important for all of our children to experience residential / out of school visits and would very much like to ensure that every child has the opportunity to take part. If you are experiencing financial difficulties, please speak to either the school office or the Headteacher in confidence as there are partial bursaries / subsidies funded by both FoNR and a historical School Fund available for a limited number of trip places.

We will be holding a Parent's Information meeting in the near future to give you an overview of activities, advice on what your child needs to pack and answer any questions you may have.

Without exception, the children all enjoy their time on residential, and it remains one of the highlights of the academic year for staff and pupils alike.
