The children had a wonderful time on Wednesday at Harrogate Theatre whilst we watched the performance of Aladdin.


The children enjoyed an ice-cream treat in the interval, with huge thanks to FONR for supplying these for us.

A new member of the North Rigton team!


We are delighted to welcome Mrs Trewin to our team. She will be working across the school, but primarily in Apples and Year 5/6 as a teaching assistant.
