Dear Parents/Carers

Sun Class trip to York Chocolate Story – Thursday 19th October

This term our year 5 and 6 children are learning about food and its impact on the environment. To support our curriculum learning, we are planning a trip to York Chocolate Story on Thursday 19th October. During the day the children will participate in a workshop and tour. We will also have an opportunity to explore The Shambles, which is adjacent to the museum.

The children will travel to and from York **by train**. Please drop your child off at Pannal Station at **9:15am** and pick them up again from the station at **3.50pm**. If you anticipate having difficulty dropping off or picking up at these times, please let school know so we can help with alternative arrangements. Your child will need to wear their school uniform and bring a warm waterproof coat, packed lunch (no nuts) and a water bottle in a small backpack.

We are asking for parents to both consent and pay for this trip via Parent Pay, by 12th October 2023. To cover the cost of this trip we are asking for a donation of £20 per child; unfortunately, if insufficient donations are received, the trip will not be able to run. Whilst we recognise that the cost of school trips can be expensive, we believe it is important for all of our children to experience out of school visits and would very much like to ensure that every child has the opportunity to take part. If you are experiencing financial difficulties please speak to the school office.

Medical information for your child will be taken from the rolling medical forms sent into school, if there are any changes please notify the school office.
