## Aspens



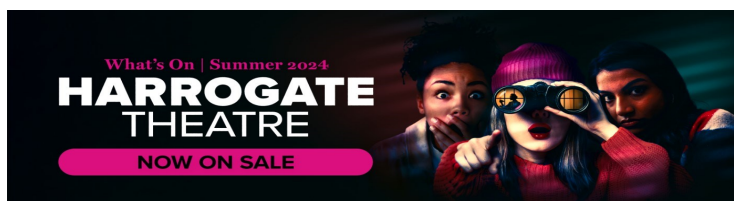
From September we will be using Aspens online payment system for ordering, paying and pre-booking school lunches.

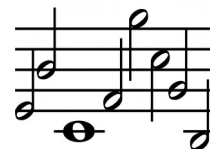
### Snacks in School
