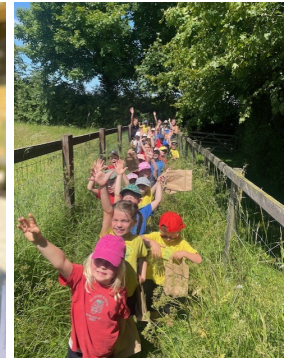
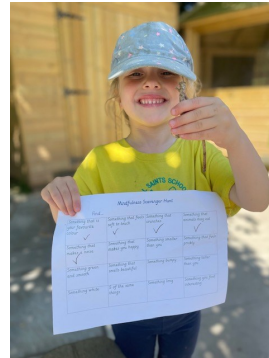
Wellbeing Day
