

Arthur's mum Jes is currently swimming the length of the English Channel in a swimming pool to raise funds for the Friends of Alfie Martin, a charity close to her heart, as Alfie is her cousin.

Jes explains: 'Alfie sadly died due to medical neglect during his birth but my



aunt and uncle had a painfully long wait for a specialist ambulance to transport new born babies to the LGI. Fast forward 23 years and The Friends of Alfie Martin is the largest fund raiser for the neonatal ward at the LGI, providing specialist equipment for new born babies requiring life saving medical treatment. Alfie's family are still based in Sicklinghall and his sister Betsy attended All Saints. This is a real challenge for me as I have a bit of a phobia of swimming in public pools!'
