4	Verbal Headteachers Report All Saints <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 16 places for reception next year. One a child about to move into the village who will need to appeal and then hopefully be given an exception for the school to go over PAN of 15. - Other numbers across the school remain stable for next year. - Staffing: - recorded in confidential minutes North Rington <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 4 additional children expected across the school next year and 12 for reception. - Staffing – recorded in confidential minutes
5	YCST Update From the Governor conference we found out: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Local Governing Boards will become committees (LGC) as that is where they sit in the Trust hierarchy. - A new scheme of delegation has been circulated, clearly showing responsibilities and accountability across the Trust. - LGC meetings will change to two per term across all the trust schools with no subcommittees. - There will be a Trust template for Headteacher reports, making use of the Arbour MIS to auto populate the data fields in the report which should make it easier for the headteachers. - The format of the Chairs' report to the Trust is being updated.

13	Further items determined for discussion at agenda Item 2: <u>SATs Results</u> NR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Was moderated for writing and outcome was very positive with school judgements all confirmed - 3 Y6 writers working at greater depth. - 75% Reading (8% greater depth) - 83% Writing (17% greater depth) - 67% Maths (8% greater depth) - It is a small cohort of 12 pupils, with a high number of SEND pupils. Their teachers over the last two years have mainly been supply teachers who have not had the INSET on Maths Mastery. - Governors expressed their thanks to SG for her work supporting Tigers this year (and in working out the staffing plan for next year!) AS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Exemplary moderation of Maths Sats - 100% Reading - 100% Writing - 88% Spelling. Punctuation and grammar. (one child!) - 88% Writing

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This was a smaller cohort of 8 and all boys. Four SEND, including one with an EHCP and 1 English as an Additional Language. Outstanding results due to the very small cohort and the targeted interventions that have been able to take place. - Congratulations to All Saints for the amazing results.
