

Reader of the Week and Golden Writer Awards


Congratulations to Mia (Y6) who has been awarded our Golden Writer Award for including all of our success criteria in her writing about the Flood.

A reminder that we have an open door policy in school and are always keen to support our families.

WhatsApp groups are a fantastic mechanism for communicating key messages between parents, however, at school we have recently been made aware of a small number of messages circulating causing some parents undue distress.

As a school, we have no oversight of the parent WhatsApp groups and are unable to take direction on what is posted. We would just like to remind all parents to be kind and to speak to a member of staff if you are concerned about any conveyed messages.

Y3—Donate children's sized PJs in sizes 4-5 or 5-6 years

Y4—Donate children's PJs in sizes 7-8 or 8-9 years

Y5—Donate children's PJs in sizes 10-11 or 11-12 years

Y6—Donate children's PJs in sizes 13—14 or 14—15 years

Arbor: First Aid Reporting and the Arbor App

Over the coming weeks, we are going to be changing the way we report first aid incidents to parents.

Instead of the paper minor injury forms being sent home, we will be notifying parents of any accidents online via Arbor. The messages will be relayed to primary guardians via email at the end of each day.



We are in the process of making this transfer and will be in touch again when this system is up and running at full capacity.

For those parents who are yet to sign up to the Arbor App, please could you do so at your earliest convenience. We have phased out the use of text messages for instant notifications as these were very expensive to send. All smaller, shorter communications will be distributed via the Arbor App going forwards.

We would hate for any parents to miss key messages as they have not yet signed up.
