Valentines Bake Sale

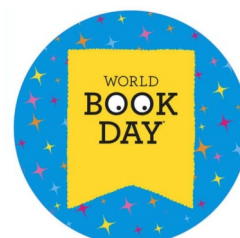
On **Wednesday 11th February** we will be holding a bake sale at pick up. Donations of cakes would be gratefully received (in the morning).
